Belgian saison yeast adds earthy sweetness and toffied-banana to give some complexity and poise, finished with a high bitterness from all of those lovely hops. Heed this; this is our biggest, hoppiest beer of the summer, consider this a warning.

The East Kent Goldings, Canterbury White Bine, Brambling Cross and Early Prolific hops impart a floral and citrus flavour with aromas of spicy marmalade and mandarin. The malt adds clean and smooth base notes with a subtle, caramel-like sweetness. Traditional English Ale yeast adds fruity flavours followed by an outstanding dry, hoppy finish.
